11. Report from Jane Horne District Councillor:-

- (i) New Cabinet at DC want to encourage joint meetings. Two members of the PC invited to next meeting in Coleford on Thursday 26 October.
- (ii) New PC in the Forest of Dean
- (iii) Boundary Changes – Tibberton will be part of Longhope and separated from Taynton
- (iv) Dementia Awareness training available.
- (v) Speeding in Tibberton – police will monitor next month and report back

12. Report from Brian Robinson County Councillor:-

- (i) Bus service from Lea to Huntley now diverted via Mitcheldean. There will only be one morning bus and one returning afternoon bus along the A40.
- (ii) Road safety campaign – launching in October – supporting material for parishes available
- (iii) Will ask Highway Manager to come to Tibberton and CC will support request for a 30mph speed limit. More money will be spent on road improvements over the next few years.
- (iv) Gloucestershire children's services have an improvement plan in place after being deemed 'inadequate'
- (v) Broadband – gaps in reception should be filled next year
- (vi) Javelin Park incinerator – will be in place by 2019 reducing the amount of rubbish sent to landfill.
