Forest of Dean Council have reacted to requests by the Parish Council on the recent flooding issues agreeing to provide FloodSax and Hydro snakes as well as an increase in the supply of sand bags for flooding emergencies. Villagers wanting to know more about these flood defences for the village should contact Parish Councillors.

Current planning applications were discussed and responses agreed. Details of parish response to planning issues are published with links on the village website.

The Spring Litter Pick took place in March and thanks must go to a number of villagers who responded clearing our paths and roadsides of discarded litter. Many commented this could be an all year round activity and the council can provide litter picks and the brown sacks that can be collected with the household refuse service.

The village has access to the services of the County Lengthsmen who provide a highways service, keeping drainage ditches clear, removing road debris and road signs clear of vegetation. The Parish Councillors have compiled a 'shopping list' and look forward to work being completed over the summer.

Following government guidance on COVID restrictions and holding Parish Council meetings in the village hall were discussed. The Parish Annual Meeting to be held in May is an occasion to celebrate and review events in the village that have taken place during the year. It is also when the finalised Parish Accounts are agreed.
