

# Tibberton Parish Council

The **Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS)** has arrived in the village. This is a road safety initiative to encourage all road users to consider their speed on our village roads. Trialling of the VAS has started, there are four County Council approved post locations in the village. The VAS notifies and records the speed of passing vehicles.

Volunteers are needed to help check and move the sign. For about half an hour every other month you could get to wear a Hi-Viz jacket! More details are on the TPC website including Risk Assessment with other documents, training will be given. It is not arduous, it is more about being safe when moving the VAS sign or changing the battery.
